For more than 2500 years Greek myths have inspired our culture and artists all over the world. Stories of gods and goddesses, mortals and monsters, their power struggles, love affairs and metamorphoses have enchanted young and old since the dawn of time.

The series aims at presenting these mythical and founding stories to international audiences in a new attractive and original way.





SEASON ONE: THE OLYMPIAN GODS & GODDESSES

From Zeus to Hermes, Athena, Aphrodite...
the series will show us the Olympian gods and
goddesses, their personalities, faults, qualities
and passions. We will follow their schemes,
adventures and tricks they used to achieve their goals.

We will find out how they were born,
how winter appeared on earth,
why the rooster crowed,
who created the horn of plenty

SEASON TWO: LOVE BETWEEN GODS & MORTALS

Season Two will tell the stories of daring tricks and lies the gods used to gain affection of those they loved. We will see how the Trojan war started and how Zeus turned himself into a bull, a swan and into a shower of gold to seduce nymphs and princesses. We will find out why love comes to some and is denied to others, why Zeus' wife adorned the tail of the peacock with eyes and allowed a young lady transformed into a cow to become the goddess Isis in Egypt...



SEASON THREE: THE GREAT STORIES OF THE ILIAD & THE ODYSSEY

Season Three will introduce the two greatest Greek heroes, Achilles and Ulysses and start with showing how they tried to avoid going to war. It will tell stories of Achilles' love, benevolence and rage and how he ultimately defeated Hector, the Trojan prince. We will learn of Ulysses' trick which put an end to the war, and how he managed to find his way back home overcoming storms, monsters and powerful magicians who fell madly in love with him.



SEASON FOUR: THE HEROES WHO DEFEATED THE MONSTERS

Season Four will present the audiences with magnificent heroes and monsters they had to struggle with: Theseus and the Minotaur, Jason and the Golden Fleece, Perseus and Medusa, Bellerophon and the Chimera... We will present outstanding accomplishments of Ulysses and Herakles, their great imagination, strength and resilience as well as gods and goddesses who helped or tried to hinder them.



SEASON FIVE: THE MORTALS WHO DISOBEYED THE GODS

Season Five will lead us through the rebellious lives of those who stood against the gods: Prometheus, Pandora, Tantalus, Sisyphus, Arachne, Narcissus, Icarus and Midas. We will watch firsthand their most difficult struggles and the appalling punishments they had to endure.



STYLE

The series will blend poetic hand animation of cut-out puppets in the mood of Lotte Reiniger's films and ancient Greek vase style iconography with modern IT visual effects such as green screen compositing, particles animation and other computer generated techniques. We believe this way of mixing the old with the new creates an original visual style attractive to both young and adults audiences.
